

Who are Sahrawis & Berbers?

The indigenous population of Western Saharais usually known in Western media as Sahrawis, but they are also referred to in Morocco as "Southerners" or "Southern Berbers". They are Hassaniya -speaking or Berber -speaking tribes of Berber origin (97% of Y-DNA).

Another paradox is that the SADR has the liberated territory within the borders of the former Spanish Sahara, but also governs the refugee camps in Tindouf, Algeria (although the majority of economically lucrative resources are found in the area of Western Sahara controlled by Morocco) (Kingsbury 2015, 2016; White 2015).

What are the dune types in the Western Sahara Desert?

The leading edge of the desert comprises smaller dunes that migrate or extend from areas where giant dunes occur downwind. Finally,simple linear dunes and barchan dunesextend from compound or complex dunes on the southwestern wadis and escarpments of the western Sahara Desert. Fig. 8.
