Who is eligible for solar PV panels?

To be eligible for solar PV panels, your home needs to meet these specific requirements: Have an income of less than £31,000. Currently have an inefficient heating system within the D-G energy efficiency band. Own your home and live in it, or live in private rented accommodation (requires permission from the landlord).

What evidence do I need to buy a solar panel?

This evidence may be in the form of a pension statement, three months' payslips and bank statements or a P60 dated in the last six months. Solar Together is a community buying scheme for solar panels operating in the UK's local council regions.
