Since independence, Equatorial Guinea has been governed by dictators from a single family, with positions of political and economic power held largely by members of their Esangui clan, a subset of the majority Fang ethnic group. The current leader, Teodoro Obiang Nguema, took power in 1979 from his uncle Francisco Macías Nguema, himself President since independence in 1968.

Equatorial Guinea's real GDP growth has been weak in recent years, averaging -0.5% per year from 2010 to 2014, because of a declining hydrocarbon sector. Inflation remained very low in 2016, down from an average of 4% in 2014. As a middle income country, Equatorial Guinea is now ineligible for most low-income World Bank and the IMF funding.

The technology group Wärtsilä; was awarded a 38 MW power plant project by the EPC company Groupement TEC-IEE in Equatorial Guinea. The project is sponsored by the Ministry of Hydrocarbons with the intention to boost the development of local industry.
