

Why is Guernsey important?

Guernsey and the other Channel Islands represent the last remnants of the medieval Duchy of Normandy, which held sway in both France and England. The islands were the only British soil that Germany occupied in World War II.

Is Guernsey a real name?

The island's name, "Guernsey", like that of neighbouring "Jersey", is of Old Norse origin. The second element of each word, "-ey", is the Old Norse for "island", while the original root, "guern (s)", is of uncertain origin and meaning, possibly deriving from either a personal name such as Grani or Warinn, or from gron, meaning pine tree.

Is Guernsey part of the UK?

Guernsey is administered as part of the Bailiwick of Guernsey, a self-governing dependency of the British Crown. The island is thus not part of the United Kingdom, although the UK government has certain responsibilities for the Bailiwick.

Was Guernsey occupied during WW2?

Guernsey was occupied during World War II by Germany. Many of Guernsey's inhabitants were evacuated to England before the Germans occupied the island (July 1940-May 1945). What type of livestock is associated with Guernsey? is a breed of dairy cattle originating on Guernsey of the Channel Islands.

When did Guernsey become part of Normandy?

Guernsey was part of the Duchy of Normandy until 1204, when the Channel Islands remained loyal to the English crown, splitting from mainland Normandy. In 1290, the Channel Islands were divided administratively and Guernsey became part of the Bailiwick of Guernsey. During the Second World War, Guernsey was invaded and occupied by Nazi Germany.

What do Guernseymen call Jersey men?

In turn, Guernseymen traditionally refer to Jersey men as crapauds ("toads"). The so-called Guernsey lily, *Nerine sarniensis*, is also used as a symbol of the island, although this species was introduced to the island from South Africa.
