

How do I expand my home assistant storage?

When you are running Home Assistant Operating System, you can use the following options to expand your storage: Replace your current storage medium, for example, the SD card, with a bigger one. Use a backup to restore Home Assistant from backup on the new SD card.

How do I free up space in my home assistant?

There are several things you can do to free up some space: Follow these steps to check the available free disk space. Go to Settings > System > Storage. Under disk metrics, hover over the status bar to view the details. The Network storage section only shows if you have added network storage. The Home Assistant database can become very large.

How do I restore home assistant to a new SD card?

Use a backup to restore Home Assistant from backup on the new SD card. If you are running Home Assistant as a VM, look at the documentation for your hypervisor on how to expand disks for virtual machines. Home Assistant will auto-expand to use the newly added space.

How do I check if my home assistant has free disk space?

Follow these steps to check the available free disk space. Go to Settings > System > Storage. Under disk metrics, hover over the status bar to view the details. The Network storage section only shows if you have added network storage. The Home Assistant database can become very large. Follow these steps to reduce the size of the database.

How do I store backups outside of home assistant?

Storing backups outside of Home Assistant makes sure they don't use space on Home Assistant to begin with. It also makes sure you can restore Home Assistant from backup in case you have an issue with your current installation. Go to Settings > System > Backups, and from the list of backups, select the backup you want to keep.

Does home assistant auto-expand?

tl;dr - Running `du -shc /* | sort -h` from the SSH add-on will show most everything except add-ons. To see add-on sizes, run `docker ps --size` from console or SSH access into HAOS (not the add-on). Running this from the SSH add-on will only show you the storage seen by the HA container (I'm probably wording some of this technically incorrectly).

Choose Configuration tab (at the top), mine had 4 balloons above the "ignore pattern" box including .storage which I removed by pressing the x then clicking SAVE at the bottom right. This prompted a restart of the add-on. Following this the .storage folder was visible in my file editor under config/ and I was able to access the files.
