

Is it possible to install photovoltaic panels on the roof of a construction site

Do you need planning permission to install solar panels on your roof?

An increasing number of people are investing in solar energy. More and more homes are having solar panels, or solar tiles, installed on their roofs. Of course, with such installations, the topic of planning permission and building regulations often comes to the surface.

Can solar panels be installed on a roof?

“The solar panels will need to be mounted on the roof by installers who understand roofing and will need some scaffold decks to safely get the panels to the roof.

Can solar panels be installed on a combustible roof?

In general terms, solar panels should not be installed on combustible roofs unless some form of fire protection can be installed between the panels and the roof e.g. concrete panels or pebble ballast. 3. Location of solar panels

Can PV panels be installed on a new roof?

Where PV panels are to be installed on an existing roof, consideration should be given to the extra weight they will add. If you are planning to install panels on a new roof as part of a new build or reinstatement, it is important to be aware of the different risk implications of different roof types (e.g. flat vs pitched).

How many solar panels can be installed on a roof?

Your roof will need to be large enough to fit a suitable number of solar panels, as there's rarely much point putting just two or three panels up there. The average solar panel takes up 2m², and your installer should leave around 40cm on each side of the array, as well as 3cm between every panel.

Can solar panels be mounted on a flat roof?

For solar panels on a flat roof, mounting systems are slightly different and can include a triangle 'ballast' box to support the panels. For solar thermal panels (with cells that use the sun's heat to warm water in a house) things are a little different.

The roof space will determine the available surface in which the property defines to locate the PV panels. It will be necessary to ensure that this surface is an easily accessible space for maintenance operations, while this ...

When installed on a flat roof, PV panels are normally fixed to a frame which is angled to capture the maximum sunlight. The frame can be held in place with ballast or, if the roof cannot take the extra weight, fixed with screws ...
