Is Israel responsible for the pager attack?

Israel's defense minister, Yoav Gallant, tacitly acknowledged his country's role the day after the pager attack, praising "excellent achievements, together with the Shin Bet, together with Mossad." Both Lebanon and Hezbollah have blamed Israel for the attacks.
