

What is the energy situation in Moldova?

Energy in Moldova refers to the energy and electricity production, consumption, and import in the country. Moldova lacks domestic sources of fossil energy and must import substantial amounts of petroleum, coal, natural gas, and other energy resources. In 2018, the primary energy supply was approximately half natural gas, a quarter oil, and one-fifth solid biomass.
