

Will Niue build a solar farm?

Niue is seeking about US\$18 million to build a solar farm as part of the island nation's plans to reduce its heavy reliance on fossil fuels. The minister for infrastructure, Dalton Tagelagi says Niue's strategic energy road map sets the ambitious goal of having 80 percent of its power generation coming from renewable energy sources by 2025.

What is Niue's energy roadmap?

Under the new energy roadmap, Niue has set a goal of 80% renewables by 2025. According to Radio New Zealand, while the main focus of Niue's energy transition will be on solar power; the potential of other renewables such as wind power, biomass and wave energy will be investigated.

What is Niue Power Corporation (NPC) funding?

This represents the culmination of years of work from Niue Power Corporation (NPC) staff, local and overseas contractors, and our development partners. Australia and New Zealand funding assistance in particular has been instrumental in the procurement of new generators, transformers, switchboard and construction of a new building to house these.

What will New Zealand do with the Niue ocean wide trust?

The project will bring Niue's renewable generation to 80 percent. New Zealand will also commit \$2 million to the Niue Ocean Wide Trust, which aims to develop a blue economy and ensure long-term ocean conservation and climate resilience.

How much of Niue's diesel fuel is used for power generation?

Approximately 69% of diesel fuel imported into Niue is used for power generation - around 800,000 litres. Under the new energy roadmap, Niue has set a goal of 80% renewables by 2025.

Where is Niue located?

Niue, the largest unraised coral atoll in the world, is situated in the South Pacific Ocean, some 2,400 kilometres northeast of New Zealand. Like many island nations, Niue is heavily dependent on diesel fuel for power generation.

Typical payback for a Solar Thermal system is highly dependent on subsidy and utilisation of hot water. Unlike with solar PV, there is no "grid" to push surplus heat into and so all the energy is used onsite. A Solar Thermal system will require more maintenance than solar PV but should last in excess of 20 years if properly maintained.
