

How do I install a solar PV system?

Install a mounting system for solar thermal or solar photovoltaic panels. Consider the roof type (material and slope), weatherproofing, installation convenience, and wind and snow loadings. Choose an appropriate racking and mounting system for the type of PV module, and install the system along with needed flashing and seals.

What makes a good solar PV installation?

Making sure that the way your system is connected to your roof is (in our eyes) the most important aspect of any solar pv installation.

What are the requirements for a PV installation?

Virtually all domestic PV installations will fall under the scope of Part P. Part P requires the relevant Building Control department to be notified and approve the work. There are two routes to comply with the requirements of Part P: Notify the relevant Building Control department before starting the work.

Can I install solar panels if I don't meet building regulations?

Your local authority can also apply for a Confiscation Order to take away any money you've earned with your system - so there's absolutely no benefitto installing solar panels that don't meet building regulations. It's crucial that your solar installation follows all building regulations.

What information should be provided to a solar installer?

Guidance shall be given on compatible solar panels and roof mounting systems. The information provided to the installer should clearly indicate how the product is installed with different solar panels and roof types including the type and number of fixings and maximum recommended spacing of brackets/rails.

How much weight can a solar roof hold?

Installers must only fit solar panels if they're sure your roof can hold their weight, and carry on doing so for up to 40 years. Fortunately, most roofs in the UK are built to hold much more than a solar panel system, which usually weigh around 20kg per square metrewhen everything's included.
