Can red bricks be used as energy storage?

Imagine plugging in to your brick house. Red bricks -- some of the world's cheapest and most familiar building materials -- can be converted into energy storage units that can be charged to hold electricity, like a battery, according to new research from Washington University in St. Louis.

Could red brick be a 'dirt-cheap' energy storage material?

D'Arcy's team is aware that research on red brick has demonstrated its potential in absorbing heat, but they say this is the first time that a "dirt-cheap" construction material might be used to provide energy storage for microdevices that are a part of the building itself.

Could a brick supercapacitor be connected to a solar panel?

These brick supercapacitors could be connected to solar panels to store rechargeable energy. Supercapacitors store electric charge, in contrast to batteries, which store chemical energy.

Still, scientists see potential in the bricks as a possible green energy solution. Whether it's massive "farms" of solar panels or home rooftop installations, solar power continues to grow rapidly as an affordable and clean energy source. But storing the power from the sun when it's not shining is one of its challenges.
