

How did Syrian rebels take control of Damascus?

In just two weeks, Syrian rebel forces have swept from the northwest and taken control of Syria's major cities in quick succession, forcing the fall of President Bashar al-Assad. The rebels moved along a north-south corridor that forms the country's main spine, to take Damascus, the capital, without a fight.

Who controls Syria?

Syria has for years been controlled by a patchwork of rebel groupsincluding HTS in Idlib and Kurdish-led groups in the country's north east, some of which have also taken territory in recent days and weeks.

How did the rebels take control of Syria?

After years locked behind frozen frontlines, the rebels mounted a lightning advance, culminating in the toppling of the president and takeover of the capital at the weekend. After taking Syria's second city Aleppo at the end of November, the rebels continued their offensive, moving south to take control of the city of Hama last Thursday.
