São Tomé and Príncipe Economic Outlook Real GDP growth declined moderately, from 1.9% in 2021 to an estimated 0.9% in 2022. The decline is attributed to the lingering effect of the COVID-19 pandemic on tourism, coupled with Russia's invasion of Ukraine, which disrupted global trade. As a small island development state, the country relies on tourism, which accounted for 43.7%

São Tomé and Príncipe is very open and highly depends on imports resulting in high indirect tax revenue. At the same time, the production and export base are very narrow, leaving the authorities with a small domestic tax base. For these reasons, the country compares unfavorably with neighboring economies and other island countries, in terms of domestic ...

São Tomé and Príncipe is an island nation off the coast of Gabon in West Africa, the smallest African country after the Seychelles. It gained independence from Portugal in 1975, although economic independence is still a long way off given the high rates of poverty that rank it among the world's poorest countries.
