On the flipside,the region is plunged into total darkness from early October until mid-February,which makes it impossible for Isfjord Radio to completely give up fossil fuels.

Is this the world's northernmost ground-mounted PV system?

"It's what we believe to be the world's northernmost ground-mounted PV (photovoltaic) system," Mons Ole Sellevold, renewable energies technical adviser at state-owned energy group Store Norske, told AFP. "It's the first time anyone has done it at this scale in the Arctic ," he said, his rifle slung over his shoulder in case polar bears turn up.

Do solar panels work in summer?

In summer, the region is bathed in an abundance of sunlight, with a " midnight sun" that never sets. The solar panels also benefit from the " albedo" effect, the reflective power of snow and ice, as well as low temperatures that improve their efficiency.
